I am requesting funding for the Hudson Public Square Renovation. The entity to receive funding for this project is Friends of the Public Square Hudson located at PO Box 1214, Hudson, NY, 12534.

This funding would be used to revitalize the 7th Street Park (formerly the Public Square), a vital civic space at the heart of Hudson, New York. The park has fallen into disrepair, with broken pavement, an abandoned fountain, and unsafe pathways, rendering the space inaccessible and underused. The restoration would occur in several phases and include child-friendly infrastructure, pathways, seating areas, and landscaping designed to improve safety and accessibility.
